Continue To Be An Example

his past week we were able to have our Vacation Bible School. The theme this year was taken from 1 Timothy 4:12 which states "Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity." Since VBS was only three days, we were only able to cover the first three attributes. So, we will look at the last three in this article.

The NKJV includes "in spirit" between love and faith. In spirit means with our inward man, our mind, and our heart. It is a phrase often used to denote



sincerity and a proper attitude. Being an example in spirit means that we are an example in our disposition. If we regularly complain about or have a pessimistic attitude towards the Christian life, we will only have a negative impact on those around us.

Next, we are to be an example in faith. The Hebrews writer gives us a whole chapter on this point. He made this statement about Abel, "and through his faith, though he died, he still speaks" (Hebrews 11:4, ESV). Faith is our trust and obedience to God. Abel showed his faith by offering up worship that would be pleasing

to God. You and I can do the same. We can also be examples of faith in the same sense that the prophets and Job were (James 5:10-11). By this faith we can continue to be examples to our brothers of dedication to God.

Finally, we are to be an example in purity. There is no question this world is perverse. Every type of wickedness is committed regularly. That is why we must be all the more diligent to not be corrupted by it. We are in the world, but we are not to be of the world (Romans 12:1-2). Rather, we are to keep ourselves unspotted from the impurity of this age (James 1:27).

All of us are an example to someone As followers of God, we must make sure our example will bring glory not reproach to His name (Matthew 5:13-16).
