Consulting God

ollowing the death of Moses, Joshua is chosen to lead the people of Israel to conquer the land of Canaan. Joshua is often praised for his faith in God when he, Caleb, and ten other men went to spy out the land. As we know, only Joshua and Caleb had faith that they could conquer the people. That does not mean, however, that Joshua was a perfect man.

In Joshua 9 we read of the deceptions of the Gibeonites. God had commanded the Israelites to not make treaties with the people of the land (Exodus




34:10-16). However, the Gibeonites came to Joshua pretending to be from a far country. So, Joshua made a covenant with them. As soon as the covenant was made it was revealed that the Gibeonites were from the land of Canaan. Notice what is said of the Israelite leadership in Joshua 9:14, "...but did not ask counsel from the LORD." (ESV) Since Joshua failed to con-

sult God, the people entered a forbidden covenant.

Then, in Joshua 10 we read of an incredible event. The Amorite kings have come together to defeat Gibeon and Israel. During this battle Joshua turned to the Lord for strength, praying that the sun would not set until he had defeated his enemies (Joshua 10:12-13). God answered that prayer, and Israel was victorious. When Joshua consulted God, the sun stood still.

In all that we do we must always remember to consult God, pray to Him, study His word, and let Him be our guide in everything.
