ay 8th, 1945 is known as Victory in Europe (V-E) Day. This day marked the end of WWII in the European countries. For many who lived at that time it was perhaps the greatest day of their lives. The greatest day in the history of the world was a Sunday in the spring of



the year AD 33. This is the day a man by the name of Jesus walked out of a tomb wherein His dead body had been laid three days earlier.

The miraculous nature of this event is certainly of great import when reflecting on that day. However, for the Christian there are also a great many spiritual truths realized in the resurrection. The apostle Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 15:17, "And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and

Through this great event Jesus also overcame Satan and death, notice Hebrews 2:14, "Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil".

The resurrection is also why the Christians assemble on the first day of the week. In fact, John calls it the "Lord's Day" (Revelation 1:10). It is a wonderful opportunity to gather to worship God and commemorate what He did for us through Jesus in the observance of the Lord's Supper.

The greatest day in human history was the day that God secured the salvation and deliverance of His people through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
