The Urgency of the Gospel

veryday across the globe an average of 150,000 die. In America, 7,700 people die every day. Of course, our Lord Jesus spoke of the eternal destination of the few and the many in Matthew 7:13-14, when He said many will enter into destruction and few will find life. The Hebrews writer reminds us that every man will *die and then the judgement* (9:27). Sometimes reality is such a downer. Is there any good news to be found?

The Gospel, euaggelion, literally means a good message; the good news. Gospel can be found more than 70 x in the New Testament. Jesus boldly proclaimed, the time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel (Mark 1:15).

Recently, my shop full of tools, equipment, and vehicles burned to the ground. As I approached my house and drove down the driveway, I could not dial 9-1-1 fast enough. Once I called and waited for the fire departments to show, it seemed like forever. In reality, they arrived in about ten minutes. My heart was pounding; they were moving with great urgency, but it wasn't fast enough. Nothing could be salvaged. Nothing was saved.

Thankfully, the Gospel saves. For it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes. (Romans 1:16) It got me to thinking. Do I act as urgently with the lost as I did with calling 9-1-1? Do I make spiritual things a priority? Are people I come into contact with just people or do I see them as being worthy of the Gospel

You can see the urgency in Missionaries. They will travel to all parts of the world while risking persecution and being separated from friends and family back home. They will raise funds and faithfully preach and teach completely depending on the support of others. Why? If they lose that sense of urgency, evangelism loses one of its core motivations.

Consider what Jesus told His disciples in <u>John 4:35</u>, Do you not say, there are still four months and then comes the harvest? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! Don't wait; souls need the Gospel now!

I once read and how true a statement, without a sense of urgency, desire loses its value. Jesus said, Surely, I am coming quickly. (Rev 22:20) Hell is real; death comes to us all; but Christ provides salvation.
